- 1926** Born in Brevik, Norway.
- 1946** Won many competitions in Norway during WWII; First place Holmenkollen Ski Jumping Jr. Division in Oslo.
- 1947** Came to the United States, as a member of the Norwegian Ski Jumping team. NCAA National Ski Jump Champion.
- 1948** Class A Ski Jumping Champion in the Pacific NW, and California-Nevada events; Fifth place in US Nationals
- 1950** Received a BA degree in Business Administration from the University of Washington. Worked as a fisherman in Alaska during the summer months to help pay for college. Pacific NW Class A Ski Jump Champion; All American at the U of Washington.
- 1956** First place Class A Ski Jump Champion in Wenatchee, WA, his last competition.
- 1958-1980** Numerous positions of impact and influence in skiing competition events, the United States Ski Association, the International Ski Federation, the Olympic Games and in Community and Ski Club affairs in addition to his professional life.
- 1967** Vice President and General Manager of the Jackson Hole Ski Corporation; President from 1968-1970, then President of Big Sky of Montana, 1975 made Chairman of the Board.
- 1971** Received the Blegen Award, highest award of the USSA for contribution to the sport of skiing.
- 1978** Listed in Who's Who in the West
